## WHITE WINE

### **Chenin Blanc, Still Bay, South Africa**

A crisp, dry white with tropical fruit flavours. It is best enjoyed as an aperitif or with light meals.

### **Sauvignon Blanc, Torreon de Parades, Chile**

Straw yellow in colour with green hues, this wine has aromas of citrus fruit and peach. The palate is young, fresh and fruity with vibrant acidity and a delicate peach finish.

### **Pinot Grigio, Botter, Italy**

Fresh Pinot Grigio with good weight and balance. Stone fruit characters and hints of white flowers are present.

As this white wine has no oak contact, the result is a fruit-driven style full of luscious tropical fruits.

## ROSÉ WINE

### **White Zinfandel, Willowood, USA**

A lively, fruity rose with aromas of red summer fruits and an attractive, crisp sweetness on the palate.

## RED WINE

### **Merlot, Still Bay, South Africa**

### **Shiraz, Katherine Hills, Australia**

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## SINGLE MALT

### **Aberlour 10 year old | Speyside | £4.70**

Nose: Sweet and full. Sherried raisins, hints of toffee and a pleasant nuttiness.

Palate: Quite full-bodied, spicy rich fruitcake, toffee notes and a creamy malty-feel

Finish: Caramel and honey, the malt still evident and the sweet spices still linger.

### **Ardbeg 10 year old | Islay | £4.50**

Nose: A ridge of vanilla leads to mountain of peat capped with citrus fruits and circled by clouds of sea spray.

Palate: Sweet vanilla counterbalanced with lemon and lime followed by that surging Ardbeg smoke.

Finish: Long and glorious; sea salted caramel and beach bonfire smoke.

### **Auchentoshan 12 year old | Lowland | £4.50**

Nose: Cereals, exotic fruits

Palate: Tannins, a little sweet barley, vanilla.

Finish: Dry and very long, a little sweetness from the barley.

### **Balvenie Doublewood 12 year old | Speyside | £4.60**

Nose: Gristy, supple nuttiness intertwined with spices. Honeyed sultanas and grapes.

Palate: Sweet with good body. Gentle spice with a little vanilla, a hint of balancing peat lurking quietly.

Dried fruit too, combining with nuts, nutmeg, cinnamon

Finish: Spicy, slightly drying, still sweet.

### **Bowmore 12 year old | Islay | £4.65**

Nose: Coastal smoke and ash soon make way for orange zest, lemon slices and some hay before becoming floral heather smoke now competing with the ash.

Palate: Lovely and rounded, honeyed initially. Vanilla, perfumed smoke, peat, blossom and oily sweetness.

Finish: Smoky and long. Sea spray, dry grass, a touch of ash and citrus.

### **Bruichladdich Classic Laddie | Islay | £4.40**

Nose: Elegantly sweet with honey'd barley, boiled sweets and orange petals. Wafts of sea air.

Palate: Red apples and white grapes, with touches of sweet cinnamon and brown sugar. Still softly coastal.

Finish: Mineral-rich malt, with toffee and more honey.

### **Bunnahabhain 12 year old | Islay | £4.60**

Nose: Fresh, sweet. Seaweed, malt.

Palate: Soft, supple. Sherry, nutty. A little sweetness, malty, juicy sultana. Slightly coastal.

Finish: Sherried, mochaccino, herbal, balanced salty tang.

### **Cragganmore 12 year old | Speyside | £4.80**

Nose: Aromatic, floral. Heather, fruit salad, creamy texture. Smoked almonds, stemmy hay.

Palate: Rich, honey, stone fruits, chestnuts, walnuts, almonds. Berries.

Finish: Smoky, good length, delicate peppery spice.

### **Dalmore 12 year old | Highland | £4.90**

Nose: Roasted coffee beans, notes of malt and cereal and butter with rich orange.

Palate: Notes of marmalade and triple sec with winter spices and fruitcake. Zesty cocoa and milk chocolate.

Finish: Medium, oranges

### **Dalwhinnie 15 year old | Highland | £4.60**

Nose: Aromatic, toffee, lush nectarine, custard. Floral, apple blossom, honeysuckle, pear, touch of smoke.

Palate: Malty. Walnuts steeped in honey. Gentle smoke with a touch of spice.

Finish: Long, malty, walnut, almond.

### **Glenfiddich 12 year old | Speyside | £4.40**

Nose: Grain. Slightly floral, mineralic. Spirity, orchard fruit, malty, honey. Citrus develops.

Palate: Light, floral, spices. Very smooth.

Finish: Sweet, touch of oak and general fruit, oily.

**Glenkinchie 12 year old | Lowland | £4.50**

Nose: Quite light, yet fragrant. Barley sweetness and nutty. Acacia honey creeps in with gentle warmth

Palate: Very fruity with notes of Madeira and sweet stewed fruits. A hint of calvados and tannic oak.

Finish: Medium length with notes of cereal and a fresh greenness.

**Glenlivet 12 year old | Speyside | £4.60**

Nose: Dates plum and apricot wine note. Orange zest, toffee, hints of struck match and chocolate raisins.

Palate: Fruity, sweet, toffee, a touch of anise, milk chocolate Flakes, banoffee pie and apple turnover.

Finish: Creamy toffee, a little oak and sweet barley sugar warmth. Milk chocolate raisins linger.

**Glenmorangie 10 year old | Highland | £4.40**

Nose: Very fruity and thick. Rich notes of lemon, nectarine and apple. Spices.

Palate: Fresh and balanced, vanilla. Boiled sweets, very creamy, tiramisu, toffee.

Finish: Quite long, gentle, malty and very fruity.

**Highland Park 12 year old | Orkney | £4.70**

Nose: Fresh floral notes abound the senses with a light grassiness. Notes of honey, citrus and sweetness.

Palate: Full with depth. Notes of granary toast and green tea with jasmine. A touch of sweetness.

Finish: Quite long with peppery spice and wood shavings.

**Isle 10 year old | Jura | £4.60**

Nose: Initial cereal gives way to smoke and heady malt. Quite sweet and creamy.

Palate: A cereal fest on the tongue, hints of white pepper and black forest honey with hot buttered toast.

Finish: Medium length with cocoa and rice paper with hints of honey and spice on the tail.

**Lagavulin 16 year old | Islay | £5.10**

Nose: One of the smokiest from Islay. It's big, very concentrated, sweet spices, mature sherry and vanilla.

Palate: A massive mouthful of malt and Sherry, but also a wonderful sweetness. Big, powerful peat and oak.

Finish: Long, spicy finish, figs, dates, peat smoke, vanilla.

**Laphroaig 10 year old | Islay | £4.50**

Nose: Opens on smoky muscular peat, spices, liquorice, and a big dose of salt.

Palate: Seaweed with a hint of ice cream and a whiff of from the first aid box. Cardamom/black pepper/chilli.

Finish: Big and drying, as the savoury, tarry notes build up with an iodine complexity.

**Macallan Gold | Speyside | £4.70**

Nose: Lemon citrus nose and orange peel . A quiet note of vanilla is followed by dark chocolate.

Palate: Citrus and boiled sweets, along with hints of ginger and cinnamon, soft oak tones and toasted apples.

Finish: The finish is medium sweet, malty and slightly dry.

**Oban 14 year old | Highland | £5.00**

Nose: Rich and smokey. Medicinal notes, with seaweed and tarry ropes. Cut hay and wood smoke.

Palate: Citrus with smooth sweetness. Smoke with notes of seaweed. Rich oak with grist and cereal and malt.

Finish: Good length with fruit and dry oak.

**Old Pultney 12 year old | Highland | £4.50**

Nose: Crisp and clean. Great balance reveals notes of herbs and grist. Parsley, almond.

Palate: Balanced with medium body. Musty, nutty, sultana, toffee, spices. Oak.

Finish: Medium, oak, spices.

**Talisker 10 year old | Skye | £4.75**

Nose: Fresh and fragrant. Through thick smoke come pear and apple peels, with pinches of salt and seaweed.

Palate: It's a bonfire of peat crackling with black pepper, with a touch of brine and dry barley. A delivery of orchard fruit provides a delicate and beautiful balance.

Finish: In a long finish, bonfire embers toast malt and crystallise a sugary underlay.

## **BLENDED MALT, BLENDED WHISKY & GRAIN WHISKY**

### **Monkey Shoulder | Blended Malt | £4.40**

Nose: Marmalade, cocoa and malt. Vanilla and a sprinkling of winter spice alongside a hint of aniseed.

Palate: Very malty, creamy with berry fruit. Toasted barley, cloves and butterscotch. Manuka honey, hot-buttered-toast and dried apricot develop.

Finish: Medium length, spicy oak and a hint of peppermint on the tail.

### **Famous Grouse | Blended Whisky | £3.30**

Nose: Light, crisp. Cut flowers. Barley. Toffee sweetness.

Palate: Light and balanced. Spice, barley. Caramel, touch of smoke.

Finish: Touch of sweetness, caramel.

### **Bells | Blended Whisky | £3.30**

Nose: Quite soft and gentle. Malted barley and hints of cut herbs and a fresh floral note. Cereal and grist with a little honey.

Palate: Quite smooth, medium body. Barley and cereals with nut oils, hints of wood and spice.

Finish: Short with notes of fruitcake and smoke.

### **Whyte and Mackay | Blended Whisky | £3.30**

Nose: Quite rich and well-balanced. There are notes of oak and resin, a touch of sherried peels and Oloroso, a little honeyed sweetness.

Palate: Quite thick with a good mouth feel. There are notes of honey and sherry and a little smoke.

Finish: Good length.

### **Johnnie Walker Black Label | Blended Whisky | £3.65**

Nose: Winter spice and treacle, hints of white pepper and a little citrus.

Palate: Rich and full with notes of wood smoke and dry spice, hints of barley and cereal with creamy toffee and a distinct herbal note.

Finish: Quite fruity and long with a note of sultanas and mixed peels.



## WORLD WHISKEY

### **Jameson | Ireland | £3.50**

Nose: Full and floral with a smooth sweetness. Marmalade and fudge, Madeira and a little cut grass  
Palate: Thick and of good body with notes of orchard fruits, both fresh and cooked with a little vanilla  
Finish: Medium-length with spice and honey.

### **Canadian Club | Canada | £3.50**

Nose: Medium-body with notes of barley sugar and aniseed, notes of cut grass and fennel, a hint of straw and a vegetal freshness.  
Palate: Quite sweet and gentle. There are notes of winter spice and dark sugars, a touch of rum.  
Finish: Medium-sweetness and of medium-length.

### **Jack Daniels | USA | £3.50**

Nose: Light with plenty of sweetness. There are hints of dry spice and oily nuts, a touch of smoke.  
Palate: Quite smooth and soft with notes of banana milkshake, a mixed nut note, a touch of caramel with crème anglaise.  
Finish: Sweet with a little cereal sweetness and toasty oak.

### **Bulleit | USA | £3.75**

Nose: Bright with orange zest, toasted oak and vanilla.  
Palate: Further orange notes, followed by some warming winter spices and a hint of tobacco leaf.  
Finish: Smooth and spicy.

### **Maker's Mark | USA | £3.75**

Nose: Fruity and rich. There are lovely notes of spiced honey and mixed peels, a little malmsey, hazelnut and a touch of cut fruit with toasty oak providing a backbone.  
Palate: Rich and full. There are notes of rye and spice, barley malt, a little nut oil with butterscotch and vanilla.  
Finish: Quite sweet with butterscotch and dry oak spice.

## WHISK(E)Y LIQUEURS

### **Drambuie | £3.50**

Made with Scotch whisky, heather and herbs and spices. Produced in West Lothian, Scotland, Drambuie offers flavours such as anise, nutmeg and saffron.

### **Glavya | £3.40**

A very popular Scotch whisky liqueur, Glavya is flavoured with honey, almonds, tangerines and spices. The name derives from the Gaelic for "very good". The liqueur is of such merit that it won the International Wine and Spirit Competition 5 times, making it the best liqueur in the world.

### **Southern Comfort | £3.40**

A very popular liqueur first made in 1874. Southern Comfort is made with whiskey, peaches, herbs and spices.
